Five Steps to Take Before Setting Up a Program



Identify Your Mandate: Decide what the objective of the program would be. Understand the Strategic Value: Determine whether and how the program will serve your organization's strategic goals. Identify and Assign a Sponsor: Select a top leader in your organization who will be an advocate and sponsor for the program. Identify Key Stakeholders and Their Expectations: Determine who will care most about the program's goals and what their expectations and priorities will be. Find and Assign Program Manager: If all prior steps move you forward toward establishing a program, find and assign a program manager.* * Some experts consider this step to be part of the program definition phase to begin the program. Others recommend it as a step before you begin the program.
